June 19, 2009 - Bothell, WA—Workforce Development Council Snohomish County (WDCSC) is pleased to announce the opening of WorkSource Bothell, a new WorkSource one-stop center serving Snohomish County and North King County.

WorkSource Bothell is located at 18132 Bothell Way NE and is open Tuesdays and Thursdays from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm and Saturdays from 9:00 am to 1:00 pm offering job search assistance, resume writing workshops, and links to skills upgrade and training opportunities at no cost to area residents.

This Center, which will host a grand opening on June 19, 2009 at 10:00 am featuring Bothell Deputy Mayor Sandy Guinn, is made possible by a partnership between WDCSC and the City of Bothell bolstered by federal stimulus funds.

"This is such an exciting time for partnerships," explains Sue Ambler, WDCSC CEO. "The city of Bothell approached us and offered this space next to the Department of Motor Vehicles free of charge for the duration of the year. With stimulus funds, we have been able to equip the center and staff it three days a week."
